Full Annual Meeting information is available on the 2024 Annual Meeting page on the Texas Master Naturalist website where event registration must be completed; both early-bird (slightly less expensive, available through August 31st) and standard (slightly more expensive, available September 1st through September 30th) registrations offer several choices including full-event, two-day, or one-day options. Applying for the Elm Fork Chapter stipend to offset registration costs is a separate process via online JotForm; details are available on the online application. Please note that other conference expenses (lodging, meals, travel, etc.) are the sole responsibility of the attendee.

Registration reimbursement requests will be reviewed as received by the TMN-EFC Executive Officers and Training Director; applicant status will be communicated as soon as possible. Application considerations include but are not limited to application completeness, financial need, first-time attendees, and desire to learn and share knowledge gained. Reimbursement funds will not be disbursed until applications are approved and the proper reimbursement request paperwork is completed (with a receipt).
